

Interview With Danny Orme - Branch Manager, East Midlands

"We have an amazing and committed team here, collectively, nothing seems impossible."

What has your journey at QFS looked like so far?

October 2017

My QFS journey started in 2017 when I took a call from a recruiter (coincidently called Danny) who told me that a businessman called Martin Johnson wanted to talk to me about potentially opening up a freight office at EMA. Of course, I jumped at the chance and made my way up to Shipley the following morning.

After a couple of hours chat and several analogies about both our backgrounds and what our visions were, we shook hands and I drove back to Derby in good spirits,

The following week I was back in Shipley to see Martin again. After another couple of hours chatting and several more analogies, Martin and I shook hands and we were game on.

November 2017

So, on November 1st, with the help and support of Duncan, we opened QFS EMA in a tiny two-man office at Regus East Midlands Airport.

My first few weeks were mainly spent on the phone, getting the first clients through the door, along with setting up dozens of new supplier accounts to handle the business.

December 2017

Thomas Key got in touch with me after word got around that there was a new opportunity here at the airport. I'd known and worked alongside Thomas in previous employment and I knew him to be solid and reliable. So, in January 2018, we became a two-man band.

February 2018

In early 2018, I set up the company's first clearance badge here at EMA and actioned the first in house clearance, which was a consignment of flowers from Bogota.

Over the next few months, we continued to recruit. This saw Tom Palmer and Declan Coyne join the team.

Further additions to our team came over time - Matt Gale, Jack Sandhu, Clare Castledine, Dan Hardy, and then, most recently in 2022, Steph Orme, my oldest twin, joined our team. We have an amazing and committed team here, where everyone has their individual strengths. Collectively, nothing seems impossible.

April 2018

I suggested to Martin that we might want to consider opening an LHR Branch, and I introduced an acquaintance to be put forward for the manger role.

Not long after, QFS LHR was born.

After a couple of years with many ups and downs and two failed Branch Managers, the Heathrow team found themselves without a manager. Feeling partly responsible for the branch at Heathrow, I didn't think twice about putting my name forward to move down to LHR a few nights a week and manage them alongside EMA.

I found it tough at times with the commuting and long hours but the LHR team showed extraordinary grit and determination. We worked extremely hard over the next few months to move the branch in the right direction. The guys down there are an absolute credit to the company, with their input and loyalty, the branch is what it is today.

October 2022

Then Grant and Paul came along. So, after just over a year of me working at LHR, Batman and Robin took over and unless I'm very much mistaken, are running the top performing branch in the company. Well done everyone at LHR!

2021 - 2022

The company gave Matt Gale and Tom Palmer the opportunity to leave EMA and open up their own branches in Leicester and Birmingham. These were amongst my proudest company moments, watching these two young lads move on to do their own thing and become successful in their own rights.

I think the key to a successful branch is in the staff for sure – I'd like to personally thank everyone who's helped and supported me over the last 7 years. This includes my team here, all the LHR guys, the Customs Department, Accounts Department, and way too many more to mention! In particular, a shout out goes to Martin, Steve, Duncan and Tracy – Thank you for the opportunity!

2025

We've moved offices 8 times within Regus over the last 7 years, to cater for the size of the team. We're due to move again at the start of next year so we're looking forward to the New Year and fresh office space for 2025!

What's your favourite way to spend your free time?

Abroad. I love to travel to different foreign countries a few times a year, whether that be on my own, with colleagues, or with my mum and daughters (and always with my laptop)!
